

LONDON (AFX) 09:42 - CustomVis PLC has launched a major reorganisation of its board- level operations, with its executive managing director and finance director stepping down, and relocating its executive functions to Perth, Western Australia.

The company, which designs and markets surgical laser vision equipment for custom surgery, said Simon Gordon has resigned as managing director with immediate effect, to pursue other non-competing business interests.

He will be "available" over the next few months to ensure a smooth handover of responsibilities.

It added Dr Mukesh Jain will assume overall responsibility for sales and marketing while continuing in his roles as an executive director and chief operating officer.

Hugh Grant has resigned as finance director with immediate effect, and will be replaced by John McEvoy, who will be based in Perth, and will also take the role of company secretary.

CustomVis said that as a result of the resignations, and having carefully reviewed the roles and location of its executive team, its has decided to centralise executive control in Perth, where the majority of its operations and staff are based.
